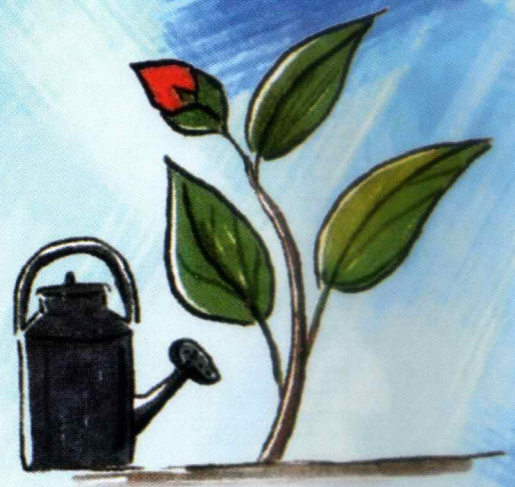

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# *Significance of* **Foundational Learning**



Early learning phase from the age of 3 to 8 years is most critical period in a child's education. It lays the foundation for lifelong well being, and overall development of all dimensions-physical and motor, cognitive, socio-emotional-ethical, cultural and artistic. This is a crucial period of intense, rapid growth and development. Early Childhood education fosters a healthy foundation for life.

Young children are unique. They are natural researchers with great observational skills. They learn through observation, imitation, and collaboration. They learn through concrete experiences. Children are leaving home for the first time and interacting with the outside world. Teachers should be sensitive and responsive to the needs & children and help them through this transition. Teachers act as a mediator between the school & home.

Foundational learning gives an opportunity to the children to expand their worlds beyond home life, to develop critical skills through play and activity. It is a stage to nurture young minds in a safe and encouraging environment. Children are natural learners. They learn best through play which includes a wide range of activities and stimulating experiences. They learn through interaction with other children. They learn about the surroundings. They develop language abilities, learn about letters & sound. They learn to count & recognize numbers. Maximum brain development takes place during this stage.

Socialization of the children in a safe environment is essential to make them overcome shyness and gain self-confidence. Children explore to discover new experiences, new friends and new environments.

It is necessary to give them right values during this stage. Teachers act as role models and help them to develop skills in managing themselves and their emotions. Children work in groups and develop team spirit, and the value of cooperating with one another. Children learn to appreciate the significance of festivals and celebrations and soon imbibe values like honesty, simplicity, love and understanding.

Thus high quality early childhood education will give the best opportunity to all children to grow into good, ethical, and creative human beings.

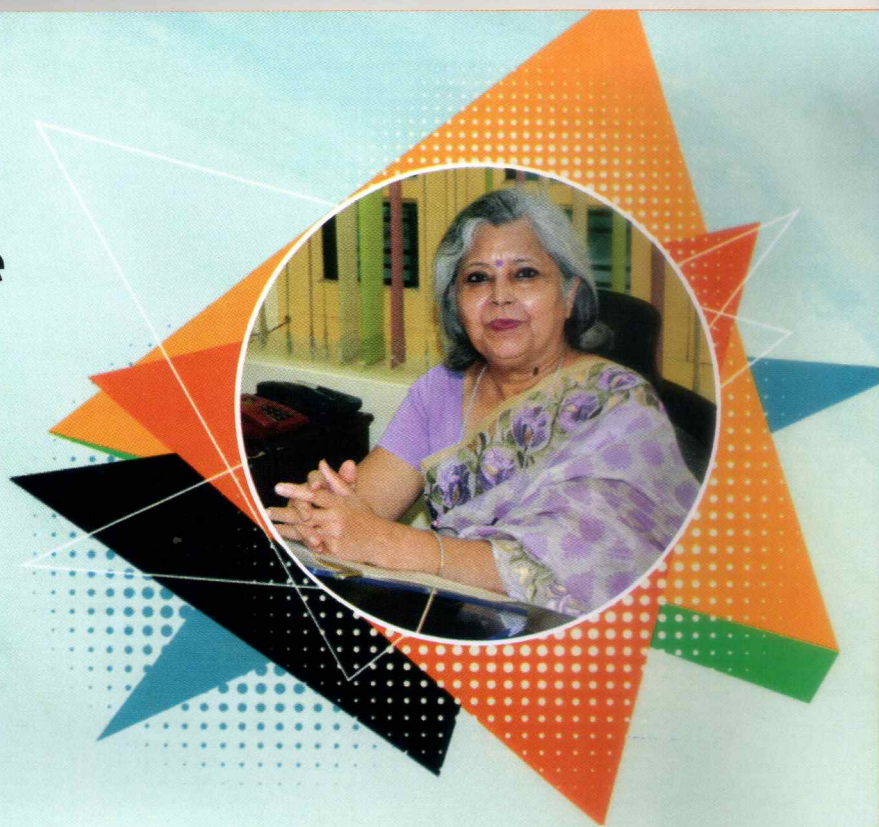

Diwali which is famously known as "Festival of Lights" is also a festival of communal harmony. The Tiny tots of PNS celebrated Diwali



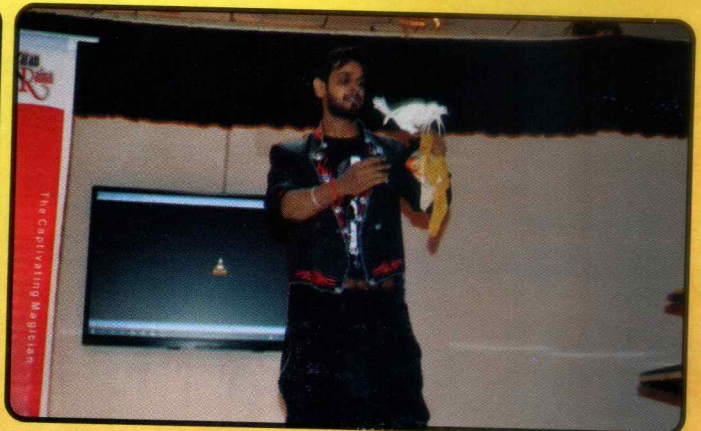

## Christmas :

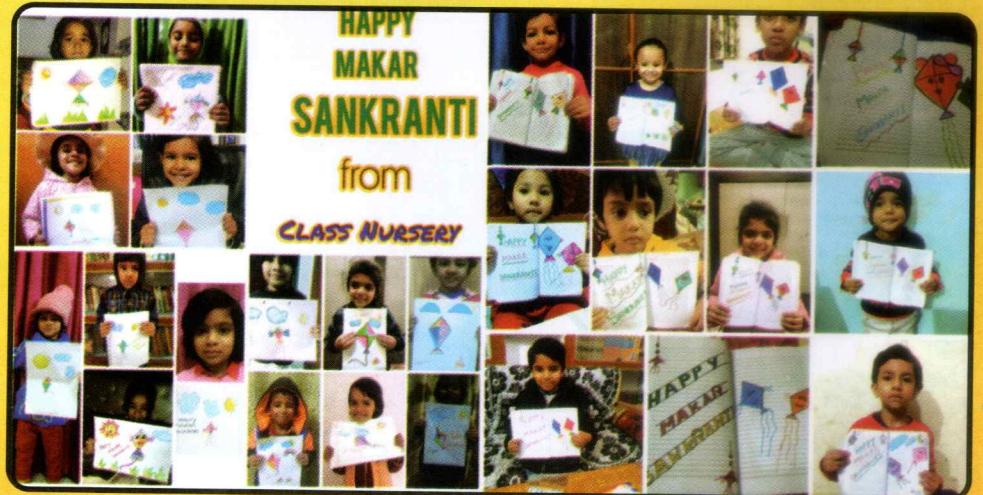

# ACTIVITIES

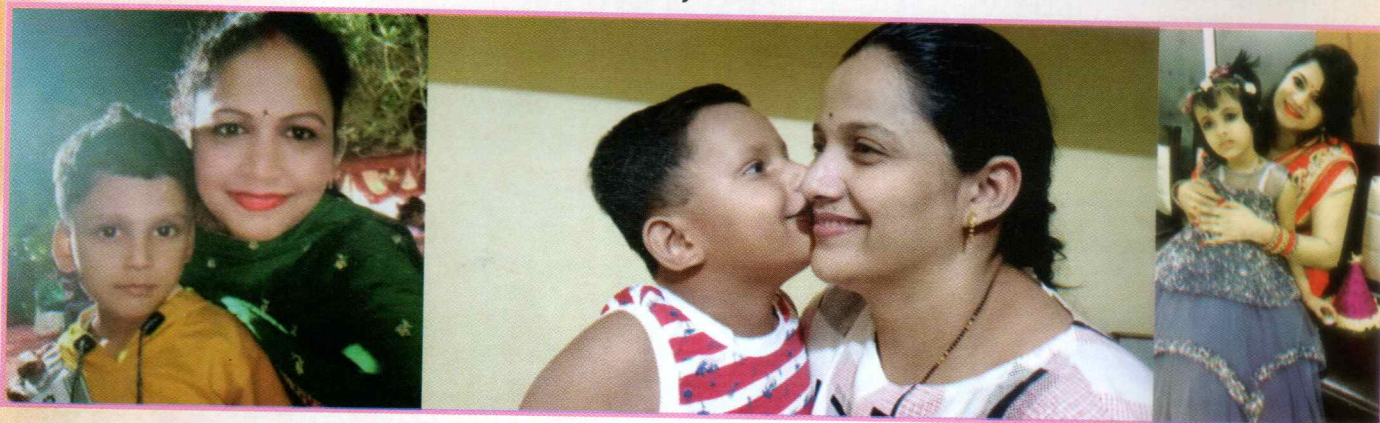
## Earth Day:

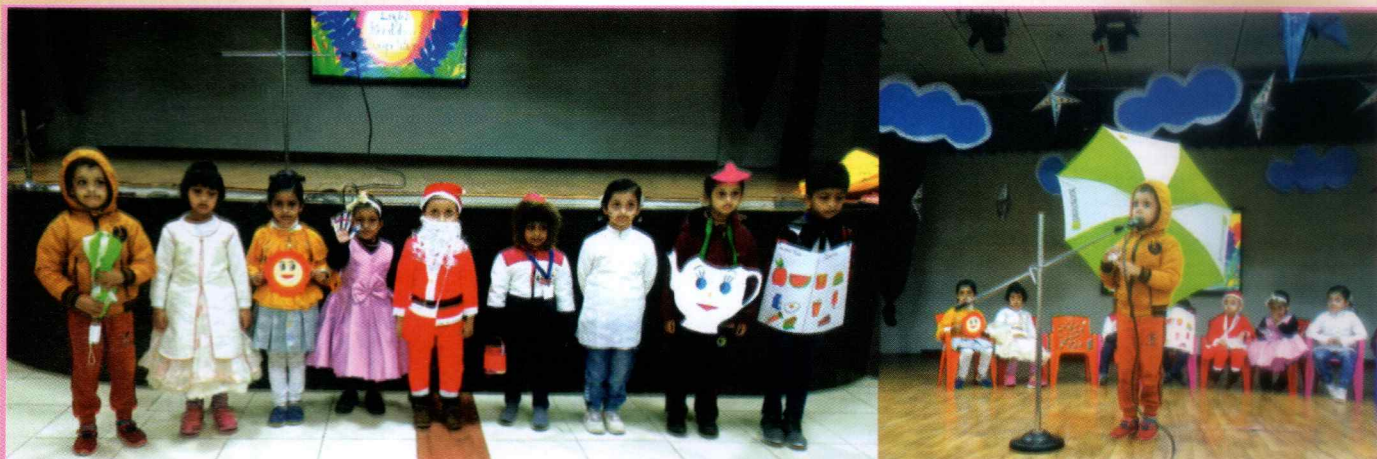
## English Recitation Activity :

Puzzles are a good introduction to the concept of fitting things together. They are an important educational learning tool for toddlers as they provide many skills and cognitive benefits.





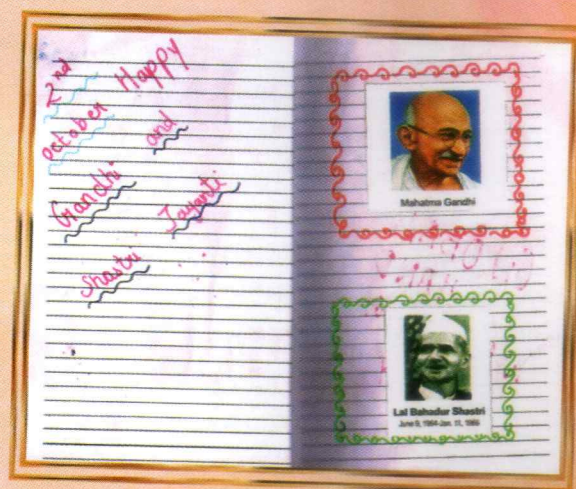
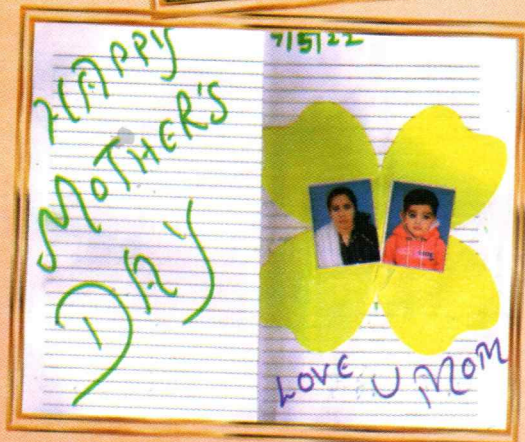

# HEALTHY DIET

Health is the most important aspect which decides the quality of life. The type of diet children are consuming determines their Physical Development, Mental Development and strength of Immune System.

Children's Diet should include Ragi, Bajra, Jowar and Corn. It can be given to them in the form of Roti or Porridge. Refined flour cookies can be substituted with multigrain cookies. These grains are rich source of Fiber and Protein. Refined flour and refined sugar should be avoided as sugar is just an empty calorie without any nutrition. It can be substituted with jaggery which is rich source of Iron and Minerals. Using honey or jaggery in place of sugar will provide nutrition and strengthening of immune system. Months old packed snacks like chips which are wrapped in plastic or aluminium packs are full of toxins, which is harmful for children's health. Instead their diet should include fresh fruits.

Fruits are high source of minerals, vitamins and energy. For fussy eaters it can be blended and should be given in different forms. Eating fruits is better than having juices as it eliminates fiber contents of fruits. Including 1 to 2 spoonful of ghee will fulfill the need of Vitamin A in child's diet and prevents constipation.

Mother's Day is celebrated to honour mother and motherhood, her selfless love and influence in society. The celebration started with the morning assembly followed by song - 'I LOVE MY



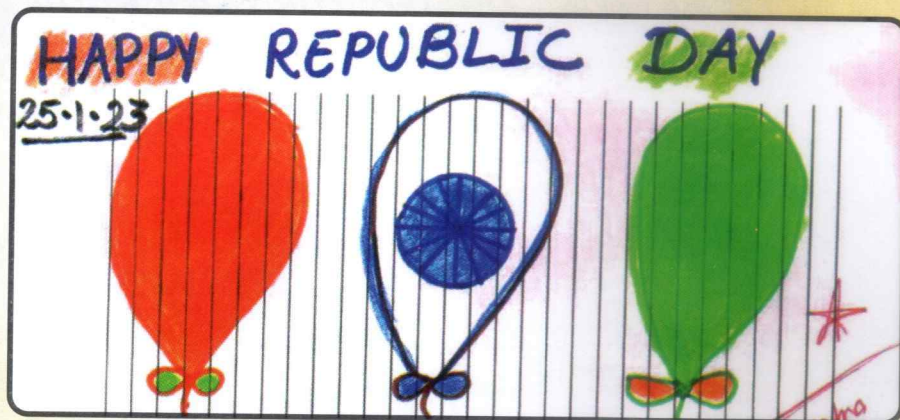


MOMMY'. A take away was prepared by the children to show their love and respect for their mother's unconditional love for them.

## Grand Parents Day :

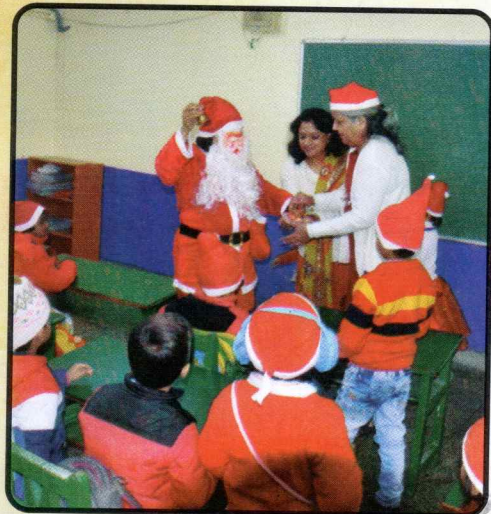
Grand Parents day was celebrated in PNS. The idea behind this celebration is to honour grandparents for all their unconditional love and sacrifice .

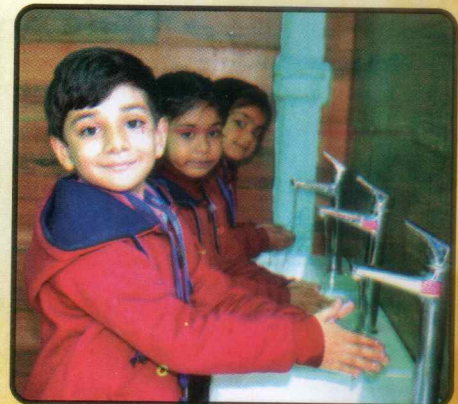
## Diwali :

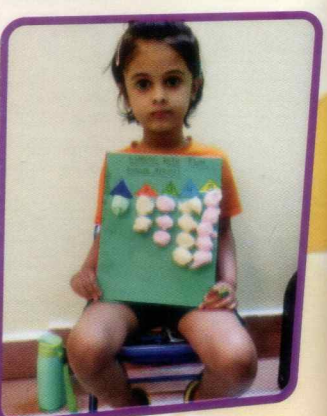
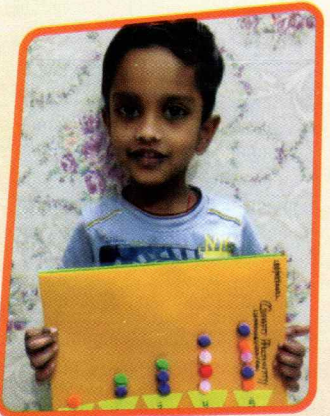
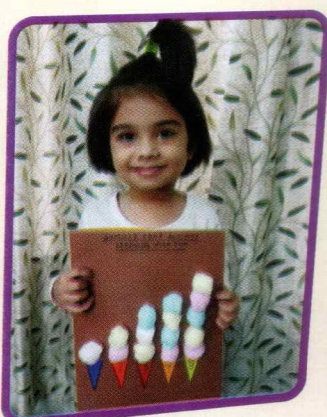
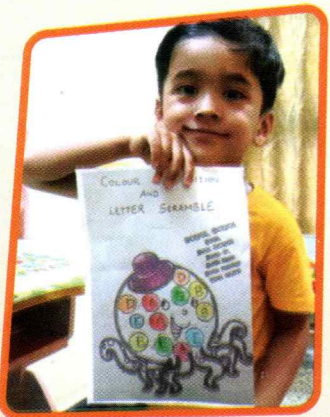
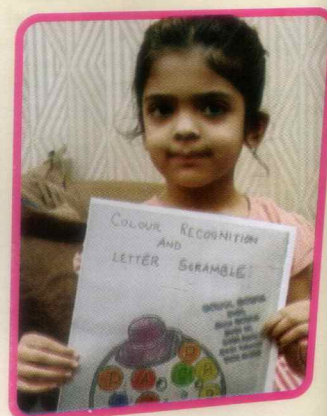
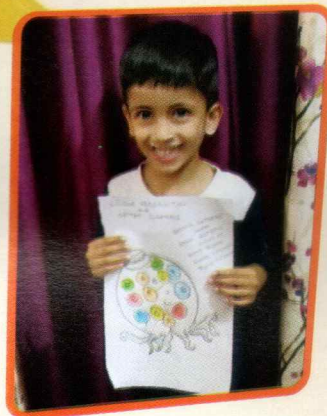
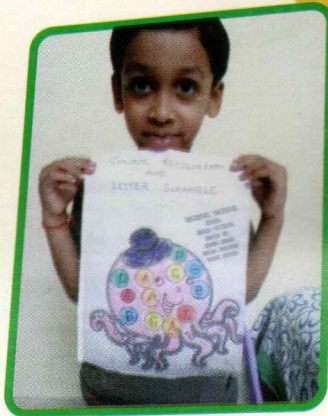
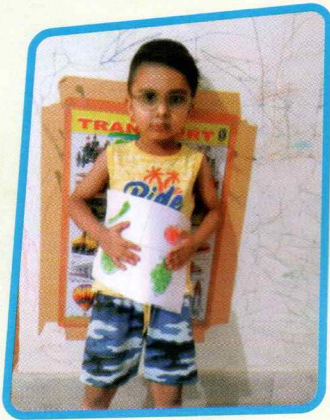


# SUMMER CAMP

As learning is the nourishment for healthy mind and body.

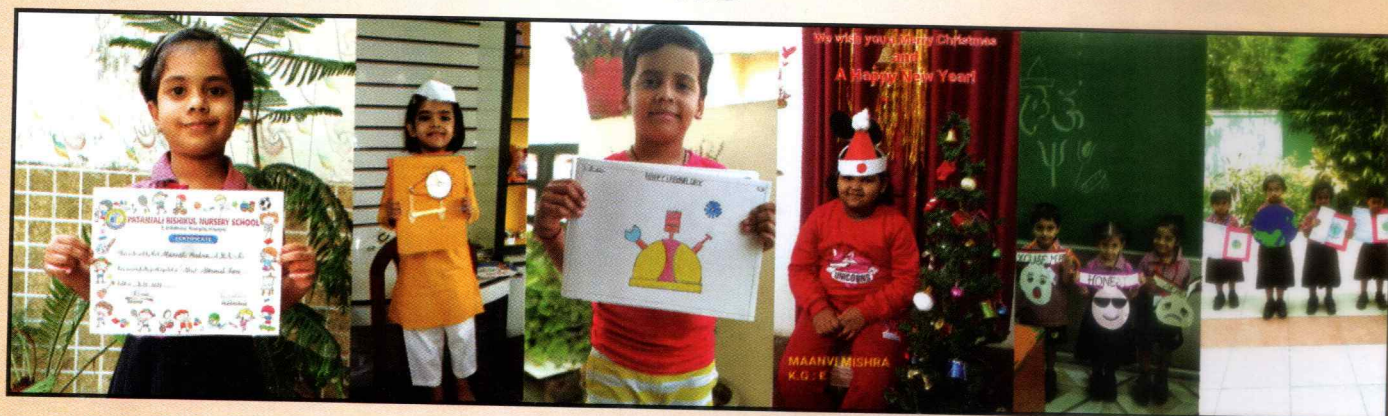

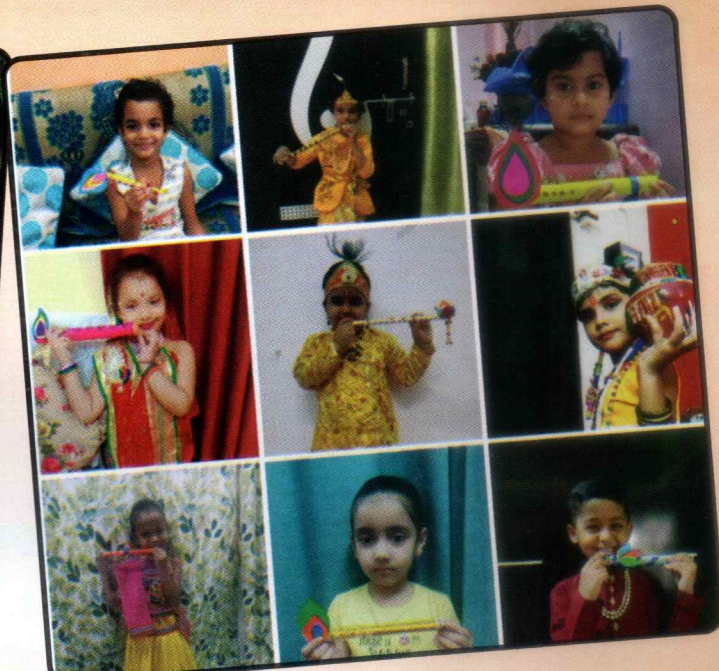
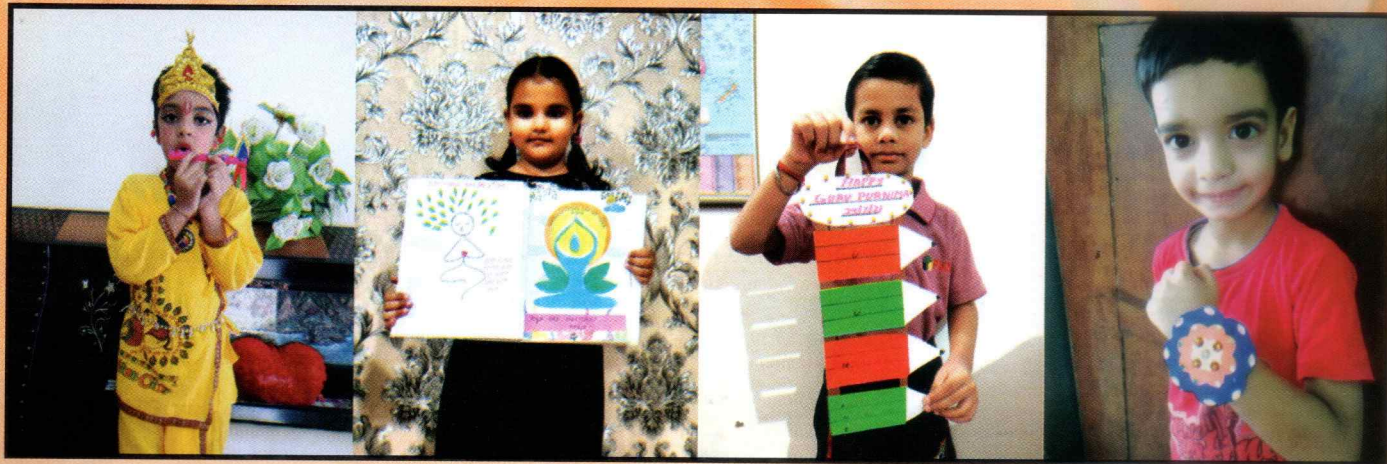
